## Variation & Grade

What makes The Atelier Series® so unique is in the wood's carefully crafted variation and grade. Variation specifically refers to the color gradients in the wood. Depending on the desired look, a wood's color variation can be enhanced with dramatic results - a floor that transitions from light to dark or one that moves minimally within the light or dark tones.

In addition, The Atelier Series uses aged character grade or select grade wood. Grade refers to the texture of the wood and the presence or near absence of natural free-forming grain patterns, knots and cracks to name a few. For aged character, Atelier floors will feature dark streaks, pinholes and knots more prominently with a notable increase in size and frequency. The wood will show greater changes in its surface texture. Larger distress markings, like checks and splits, show more freely. Our select grade wood on the other hand minimizes those elements for a cleaner, smoother surface without any of the distress.
