Our deep understanding of colour drawn from our expertise in LVT has enabled us to create this chic and minimalistic collection, featuring dark and atmospheric hues lifted by a gentle hint of metallic yarn.

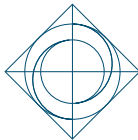
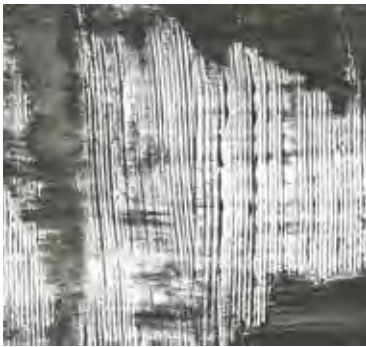
Sierra reflects the neutral tone of concrete, whereas Atlas is inspired by pleated fabrics and ridges found on antique books. We combined this base with a linear flow, enhanced by metallic yarns and featuring both graphic and organic detailing.

Pushing the tufting technology created a richer depth. Each colourway's darkest yarn is a mix of tip shear and loop, which gives more colour intensity yet keeps the tile durable. These techniques create the sort of finish that you might expect to see in a natural silk rug but with a much higher level of functionality for busy environments.

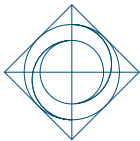
Interpreting an iconic pattern such as herringbone or twill into the intricate details and texture of carpet was a creative challenge that as a studio, we were keen explore.



We worked closely with our manufacturing teams to push the large-scale manufacturing process and give us the individual crafted quality we were looking for. The result is a collection of deep colours and soft contrasts which tie in so well together.

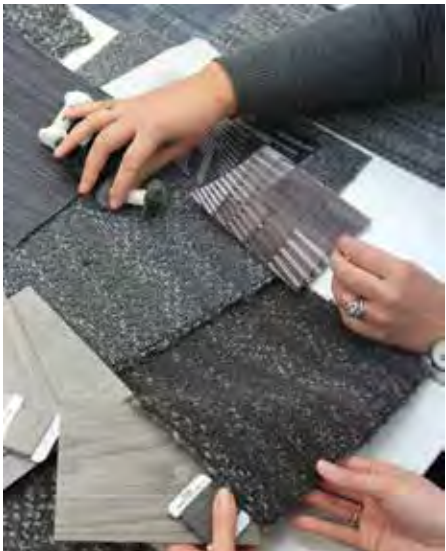
Cable features woven structures which contrast beautifully for added depth. Croft uses tonal blends for an overall loop texture. The two patterns have been designed to complement each other rather than match exactly, adding dimension and luxurious texture to a floor space.

Receiving & Checking Materials

Please inspect tiles prior to installation to verify their type and colour. Unfortunately we cannot accept claims if tiles are installed with obvious defects.

Acclimatisation of Materials

Boxes of tiles should be stored flat. The temperature of the installation location must be stable and between 18-27°C. Tiles must be conditioned to room temperature for 24 hours prior to installation. These conditions must also be maintained during and for 48 hours after the installation is complete. Amtico Carpet tiles should not be installed externally.

Subfloor & Preparation

Dust, dirt, debris, and old adhesive residues must be removed before installation begins. Surfaces must be sound, smooth and level with all holes and cracks filled with a suitable smoothing compound.

Subfloor surfaces must be tested for moisture content and should comply with the relevant local regulations – for the UK this is 75% RH maximum. Moisture in excess of the recommended levels can cause the adhesives to chemically break down and fail. This condition can result in shifting, peaking; or edge curling of the tiles.

Adhesive Selection

Tackifier adhesives are recommended for most general areas for a releasable bond. If you have any areas of intense use or temperature changes, please consider using a full bond adhesive.

Typically allow tackifier adhesives to dry so that the adhesive does not transfer when touched. Please refer to the chosen adhesive manufacturer’s recommendations for full instructions.

Installation

We recommend using a mock up area to allow all parties to review modules in various configurations i.e. Monolithic, Quarter Turn, Ashlar etc.

For square tiles starting in the corner of one quadrant, please install tiles in a pyramid fashion. Install by butting edges together evenly, being careful not to compress tiles as this can cause peaked edges. Arrows are embossed or printed on the tile backing to show pile direction.

Carpet tiles will require cutting at perimeters, floor electrical outlets and door openings. Loop pile tiles may require some trimming or clipping of tufts. This is typical of this type of construction.

Some carpet styles require more attention from installers during installation. Due to the light row, dark row construction of these products, dark lines may appear at the edges. This is not a manufacturing defect and the product may require shifting around to avoid dark lines at the edges.

If fitting to stairs, please use a suitable stair nosing and cut tiles to fit nosing on both step and riser, spreading adhesive to both the substrate and reverse of the tile.

Pallet & Box Sequencing

It is very important to install Amtico Carpet tiles in the order they were manufactured. This is easily accomplished by selecting pallets in sequential order and following the numbers located on each carton of tiles. Typically an installation will begin with the lowest carton numbers and progress through to the highest numbers until the project is complete. Installing Amtico Carpet tiles by carton sequence will ensure the most uniform finish.

Cleaning & Maintenance

With the correct maintenance regime, your carpet will last longer and become an even better investment.

We recommend using Amtico Entryway at all external entrances to limit the amount of soil and moisture entering the building. This should be specified to suit the footfall and usage of the building and should be regularly maintained to ensure it remains as effective as possible.

Daily Cleaning

The most important step in maintaining your carpet is vacuuming, as a good quality vacuum will remove 80% of soiling from the carpet.

We recommend either a dual motor upright with a beater bar, or a canister vacuum with powerhead for the most efficient productivity.

Please remember to use the correct size and type of vacuum for your carpet area and available cleaning time.

Spot Cleaning

We recommend carrying out spot cleaning daily on stains. Spray spot cleaner on the stain and the surrounding area and allow the solution to remain for 5-7 minutes, while gently working solution into the pile with a small brush.

Clean an area 3 to 4 times larger than the size of the visual stain. This will help eliminate wick back problems. Apply a clean damp absorbent towel to the affected area and dab spot out or rinse with a portable hand extractor to draw the stain out of the fibres. Do not scrub the area. Rinse properly with water, as residues of detergent will tend to accumulate dirt and create marks.

Chewing gum can be removed with freezing spray to freeze the gum for easy removal.

Periodical Cleaning

To keep your carpet tiles in good condition we also recommend hot water extraction – the frequency will depend on footfall and soiling levels. This will usually require three stages:

Stage 1:
Pre-spraying. This brings better results by allowing the cleaning chemical to break down stains and soil. Allow the solution to remain for 5-10 minutes.

Stage 2:
Agitation. Following the pre-spray, agitate with a carpet rake. This helps lift and suspend dirt from the bottom of fibres into the cleaning solution.

Stage 3:
Use a hot water extraction machine to rinse out the chemical and the soiling. A good quality extraction machine can help you achieve a drying time of just two hours. Please note: Amtico does not recommend the bonnet method of cleaning.
